Topic: BOAT PEOPLE

Summary: *In the aftermath of the Vietnam War, thousands of civilians in Indochina fled repressive regimes, precipitating a refugee crisis that Vice President Mondale and President Carter had to confront during their administration. The administration responded by supporting a surge in adoptions, admissions of these refugees to the United States (with many resettling in Minnesota), and policies to support the new arrivals.*
