Summary: From his days working as a field organizer for Hubert H. Humphrey's Senate campaign, Mr. Mondale was a strong supporter of the DFL and Democratic parties. As his stature grew throughout his career, he increasingly used it to support fellow Democrats and to strengthen the party establishment.
